1724 I the said ~~John Dozor~~ ^{John Dozor} of the County of Richmond and parish of St. John the Baptist being very weak
of Body but of perfect sense and memory thanks be to Almighty
God for the same I Do constitute and appoint this my last
Will and Testament in manner and form as followeth first and
principally I Recommend my soule to God who gave it me and my
Body to the Ground from whence it was taken

Item after my Debts and funeral Charges being fully paid & Discharged

Item I Give Three hundred pounds of Tob. towards the Schooling of
Wm Dozor son of John and Sarah Dozor

Item I Give Three hundred pounds of Tob. towards the Schooling of
Mary Welch Daughter of Richard & Mary Welch

Item I Give to John Dozor my Case of Bottles

Item my Will and Desire is that all the Rest of my Estate both Royall
and personall be Equally Divided among my Father George Dozor
and my Brother Thomas Dozor and my Sister Elizabeth and their

hearts of those. Body, Painfully to be forgotten

I Do Constitute and appoint Will: John Taylor Esq. of the County of
Will and Testament and my Decease that my whole Estate be by the
Discretion of my said Exor. Turned into money and to send it to my wife
if alive or to her and her issue living in a place called ~~Richmond~~ near to
Lockport being about twelve miles from White Plains

I Do publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament. Signed with
my hand and sealed with my seal this Day and year first above written
My Will is that M^r. Dobutts be
Employed to preach me a funeral Sermon
