Item. I Give and bequeath unto my Son George Davis one Shilling as afores.

Item. I Give and bequeath all my Stock of Cattle and hogs and my horse and mare
to my Loving Wife Ester Davis and my Son Peter Davis to be Equally
Divided between them

Item. My Will & Desire is y^t all my Goods & their furniture & all my Pewter &
brass & Iron & my Gunns & all my other household Goods what ever be
Equally Divided between my Loving Wife Ester Davis & my Son
Peter Davis

Item. My Will & Desire is y^t my s. Loving Wife Ester Davis be full and
Sole Executrix of this my Last Will & Testam^t. hereby Revoking all
former Wills by me made or Spake In Testimony whereof I have
Signed this my Last Will & Testam^t at Sittenbure in the County of Richmond this 20th Day of January 1722
