and Testaments Heretofore made by me Whether Verbally or Instrumentally
In the first Place I Recommend my soul to the Almighty god who gives it nothing Doubting
but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again and my body I Recommend
to be Decently Buried at the Discretion of my Executors and with what worldly Estate it
Hath pleased god to bestow on me in this world I Bequeath in manner and form Following
That is to say First and Principally I give and Bequeath unto my well beloved Wife Mary
Inskip the Rentation whereon I now live with all its appurtenances for and during her
Widowhood Likewise all my Personal Estate During her Widowhood this to say all my Debts
and funeral Charges But after my said Widow Marys it is my Will and Desire that my said
Estate return to my son Thomas Inskip and the Heirs of his body lawfully begotten and for want
of such heirs it is my Desire that my said land and Estate return to my son Richard and the Heirs
of his body lawfully begotten and for want of such Heirs my desire is that my said land should
be Equally Divided between my two Daughters Anne and Sally Inskip and the Heirs of
their bodies lawfully begotten Likewise my Desire is that if my Wife Marys that my Personal Estate
should be Equally Divided amongst her and my two children Likewise I Desire that John
Inskip godfather to my son Richard shall have him in Execution after the Space of six

of such nature it is my desire that my lands my fall and I come to my son Richard and the heirs
of his body lawfully begotten and for want of such heirs my desire is that my lands should
be equally divided between my two Daughters Ann and Sally Aspers and the heirs of
their bodies forever. I desire my desire is that if my Wife Marys that my Personal Estate
should be equally divided amongst her and my four children. I desire that John
Sible her father to my son Richard shall have him in possession after the space of six
years to put to any other location he shall think proper for him to get a living.

Lastly I appoint my Dear Wife and John Sible Executors of this my Last Will Revoking and
Disannulling all Wills and Testaments heretofore made by me Whether Verbally or
Instrumental. In WITNESSE Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this Ninth Day of June
In the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven hundred and Sixty four.
