 John Bailey shall be free at sixteen years of age unless he has a years schooling and
 if he have a years schooling to serve while he is One and twenty and my will is that
 my Son John shall be free as soon as please God I am deceased fourthly I give unto my
 daughter Elizabeth all my lands that lies on the north side of the middle Swamp which I
 bought of John Murre to have and her heirs for ever which land William hardly now lives
 on and fifthly my will is that my wife Ann shall have all the rest of my manors estate and
 sixthly my wife Ann shall be full and sole executor of this my last will and testament as
 witness my hand and Seal.
