do hereby certify that I have given and bequeathed by my last Will and Testament perfect Memory Thanks be given unto God the Father of all Mercies and the
most worthy of my God & knowing that it is appointed unto all Men once to die
do make public the my last Will & Testament that as I have given and
bequeathed my dear children of the County of Lancaster and I am hoping that
at a General Resurrection I shall receive my inheritance by the mighty power
of God, and as touching such worldly Estate whereunto I have been and I do to
help me with I give and bequeath I give as follows.

I give and bequeath unto my Brother Daniel Arnolds one feather bed and
pillow one. Ruger & three blankets one horse 10 shillings of Calcutta, one and
saddle & bridle now at Will. Rings and the town garden of Black Desert -
living & dying. —

I give and bequeath unto my Cousin Mr. Arnolds my other horse bid to
be now at Daniel Arnolds and one shilling of bread & butter living and -

Trimings and four yards of Kersey and as much Cloth of Henry Coats as will make him a pair of breeches and seven yards of fine Lining and on pt Shirts.

Item I give bequeath to my Brother Daniel Eight yards of fine Lining and one pair of elegant breeches.

Item I give to Charles Morris one great Coat Close Bodice Coat Vest & breeches and Shirt Shirts and Stockings as I have on.

Item I give my Brother Dr. Sawtuck one fine hat.

Item I give to my Brother Daniel I bequeath all my Estate Inherit before given and my Will in that my Brother Daniel I give all my Estate Inherit to me by bill or Ac. and also pay all my Debts out of it and I do constitute and appoint my well beloved Brother Daniel Sawtuck sole and sole Executor of this my Last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 17th Day of December 1718.
