Testament in manner and form as followeth Viz.

First I give & bequeath unto John Thornton Jun^r my Horse bridle & Saddle and wear-
ing cloths, and after my just Ditts are all paid the remainder of my Estate to be equal-
ly divided between John Thornton Jun^r my Sister Betty Thornton and her Daughter
Ann Reynolds. I do also appoint John Thornton Jun^r to be my Executor to this my last
Will & Testament Witness my hand this first day of December 1790.
