House he now lives in which I give to him and his heirs forever
also I give to my son Nathaniel a two year old Steer
Here all the Rest of my land I Give to my son John Thrift and his heirs forever
I also give to my son John my Yoke of Horses & my mare called Nancy
Here I Give to my son Maryman my wearing Apparel
Here it is my will and desire that all the Rest of my Estate be Equally divided Between
my Children John, Nathaniel, Maryman, Samuel & my Daughter Amandine Thrift & their
heirs but in case my said Daughter Amandine should Intermarry with William
Pooley or live with him it is then my will & desire that she should have no part of
my Estate I constitute and appoint my son John Thrift my Executor my Heirs
and seal this 10th day of September 1789.
