I have given unto my son Jonathan One Negro Man named Jacob to him
& his lawful heirs forever
I have given unto my son Manly One Negro Girl named Winney to him
& his lawful heirs forever
I have given unto my Daughter Jane One Negro Boy named Peter to
her and his heirs forever
I have given unto my Daughter Margaret One Negro Boy named James
When she arrives to the Age of Eighteen Years or Days of Marriage
I have given unto my Son John One Negro Girl named Lydia to him
& his lawful heirs forever When he arrives to the Age of Twenty Years
I have lived with my dear & loving Wife Elizabeth during her Widowhood or
Life One Negro Man named Jupiter & One Negro Woman Moll & the Land and
Plantation that I now live on. It is my Will & Desire that my Wife & I shall
Have the Use of all my Negroes until my Children Come of Age if my
Wife & I should die

Plantation that I have done & I do my Will & desire that my Wife & shall
Have the Use of all my Estate untill my Children coming Age if my
Wife should survive or Dy before that my son John Arrives to the Age of
Twenty Years that all my Children then under Age & the Estates Belonging
to them shall continue on my Plantation untill my son John Arrives
to the Age of Twenty Years.

I have given unto my dear & Loving Wife Elizabeth during her Natural
Hours of all my personal Estate but her Death to be Equally Divided
Between my Children.

I do nominate & appoint my Friends Samuel Williams, Luke Williams
& Daniel Everett to be my Executors for My Wife Mary Jane
Hewitts & my Land & Real Estate this 8 Day of May. 1761.
