and my body I commit to the earth from whence it was taken to be
Recently buried by my wife herein after named and as for the worldly
good and estate the Lord hath been pleased to bestow on me I dispose thereof
as followeth
I give and bequeath to my son Samuel Hammond one two year old heifer and two cows
I give and bequeath to my two sons Jacob and Job Hammond five shillings
each I give and bequeath to my four Daughters Susannah Elizabeth
Mary and Ann each one shilling each I give and bequeath to my son
Thomas Hammond my three negroes and all the rest of my estate and

And Buriall after saying my last Oath and Legacies herein before
mentioned I appointed my son Thomas Hammond whole and sole exe-
cutor of this my last will and Testament binding all others thereto with
heretofore by me made in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
this 18th day of October

1758

At a court held for Richmond County the 6 day of November 1758
This Will was presented into Court by Thomas Hammond the Executor
Therein Named who made Oath thereto According to Law and being
Proved by the Oathes of the Witnesses thereto was Admitted to Record and
on the motion of the said Executor Giving Security a Certificate is granted
him for Obtaining a Probate thereof in due Form
