In the Name of God Amen I Edward Dozier of Northampton
County of Massachusetts being very sick and weak of body but of
perfect Sense and Memory Do hereby make my last will and testament
in full of my mind and memory to be in full force and effect in good
Christian Burial and Burial of my Body after my death.

First I will that my Body and funeral Charges be paid and discharged
from my Goods and bequests all and every my Land and Tenements whatsoever
to be Equally Divided between my Loving Son Wm. Dozier Mark Dozier
John Dozier and Anne Dozier to be Equally Divided between my Sons as
above and their heirs lawfully begotten of their body for ever And its
further my will and pleasure that if any one of my Sons or of my
Daughters or of my Sons or of my Daughters should die before he or she
shall have by an Equal Division as above and if in Case my Sons or Sons all
die and my Daughters I will that then it is my will that the same of my
to be Equally Divided as between my two Daughters Ann and Elizabeth
and their heirs for ever.

And I give and bequeath unto my two Daughters Ann and Elizabeth

that my Son James Tume have of Bed and furniture of glass: —

Item: I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Tume one feather bed and furniture, one Iron pot about eleven gallons and a great Table and forme if my Daughter Elizabeth before the James Tume my Son's Request into my Loving Son Tho: Tume and his heirs for ever. —

Item: It is my Will and Desire: that my Loving Son James my eldest Son may take my two Daughters Anne and Elizabeth Tume and their governours untill they come to y^e Age of sixteen, And then they are feather bed and furniture that I give to my Daughter Anne and her heirs and y^e female Inheirs to my Daughters and y^e Male Inheirs to y^e said James Tume, And y^e Rent of my Plantation that Tho: Tume now lives on y^e Long off it Rent as by my Deeds: and when my Daughters come to Age of sixteen y^e after: then their share is y^e female Inheirs and y^e Bed and furniture to be divided as, up to them. —

Item: I give and bequeath to Loving Son Lewis Tume two feather bed, bolster and one small white Rugg that belongs to y^e wood and the Rent of Peter Place. —

Item: I give and bequeath all and every the Remains of my Personal Estate whatsoever to be Equally Divided between my first Son John, Wm: Mark, Thomas and James Tume. —

Item: It is my Will that my Loving Son John Tume my first Son y^e Plantation whereon I now live and keep his four Brothers in Christian Manner till they come to y^e Age of Eighteen and then to Deliver up to them their Estate. —

Item: I constitute and Appoint my well beloved Son John Tume to be my only Executor: of this my Last Will and Testament cooordinating his making and making void all former Wills and Testaments by me heretofore made satisfying and confirming this and no other: to carry Last Will and Testament in that which I have hereunto set my hand and

Item: I give and bequeath to Loving Son Lewis Time and further bed, bedfellow and one small white Rugg that belongs to my ~~estate~~ ^{estate} of Peter States.

Item: I give and bequeath all and every the Remainder of my Personal Estate whatsoever to be Equally Divided between my first Son John, my Mark, Thomas and James Time. —

Item: It is my Will that my Loving Son John Time ^{shall} have one of a plantation wherein I now live and keep his four Brothers in Christian Manor till they come to y^e Age of Eighteen and then to Deliver up to them their Estate. —

Item: I constitute and Appoint my well beloved Son John Time to be my only Executor of this my Last Will and Testament revoking all and making void all former Wills and Testaments by me heretofore made ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my Last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto signed my hand and Seal the Twentieth first of September 1717.
