for shall be bound to my Children or heirs and be Equally Divided
as the Rest of my Estate Lastly I nominate and appoint Joshua
Singleton my Executor of this my Last will and Testament in
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Text my seal
this 16 Day of October 1762
