I Give Elizabeth Willington Two Pounds Ten Shillings -

I Desire all the Rest of My Money to be paid out in Potters and delivered
To Margaret Bugh at the Day of Marriage or Twenty one Years of Age
I leave my last & true Will & Testament of

I leave my best & Quilted Bedcoat To Mary Willens -
I leave my Gown & fanny To Luddy Willens Daughter of John -
I leave all my cloths to Use Equally divided between Elizabeth Willens
& Sarah Bugh her Daughters -
My Will is that Henry Bugh be my Heir and sole Executor of this my
Last Will and Testament all Whom Wills by me before made of
Witness my Hand this 6th Day November 1766 -
