and in the County of Richmoud being in Good Health and perfect Sense and memory frame the
Manner by God for the same or constitute and appoint this to be my last Will and Testament
in manner and form following, that is to say first and principally I commend my Soul to God
who gave it me and my body to be decently buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereof named
and of my worthy Estate which He hath pleased God to bestow on me I Dispose of as follows
My Will and Desire is that all my just Debts and funeral charges be first paid and Discharged
I send to my Niece Ann Sandy all my West India Land during her Natural life also I send
to my Niece Ann Sandy five negroes named Will. Henry, Sam. Sarah and Hannah during her
natural life and after her death I give Negro Will to James Sandy Son of Ann Sandy five
I give and bequeath unto Winnifred Sandy Daughter of Ann Sandy all my West India Land
and three negroes named Henry, Sarah and Hannah to her and the heirs of her body
Lawfully Begotten for ever.
I give and bequeath to Mary Sandy Daughter of Ann Sandy one Negro named Joe for ever
I give and bequeath to Margret Thompson Daughter of John Thompson one Negro named
Dwelling plantation and all my Land in Richmond County and two negroes named Ruth
and Mary and one brass furniture standing in the Innards Room one oval Table and one
Raw Leather Trunk and one large Chair to her and the heirs of her body Lawfully Begotten for
and for want of such heirs I give the said Land and Negroes and household goods to her Sister
Elizabeth

and for want of such living Give the said Land and Negroes and household goods to her Sister
Sarah Let Truettson to her and the heirs of her body lawfully begotten forever also Give the
Truettson one Negro named Jane forever and to be paid to her at the age of Eighteen years or
Married on and before

11 Give to my niece Mary Sandy one bed and furniture one Christ that was her fathers and
Head of bottle young and old during her natural life and after her Death Give the same bed
Christ and cattle to her Daughter Williammoley Sandy forever

12 Give to Williammoley Sandy Daughter of John Sandy and Mary his wife Fifteen pounds
Current money to be put out upon Interest till she shall come to the age of Eighteen years
or Married and if she do Die before she come to that age or Marry then Give the same
money to her brother John Sandy forever

13 Give to Adam Sutton Son of James Sutton and Lucretia his wife Ten pounds Current
money at my Death

14 Give to Joseph Sutton Son of my friend Richard Sutton Thirty Shillings Current money
15 My Will and desire is that my two Negroes Anne and Tom should have liberty to
choose who they would live with amongst my Kindred after my Death

16 My Will and desire is that my wearing clothes should be Equally Divided betwixt my
Niece Ann Sandy and my niece Bridget Spruce and my Niece Mary Sandy

17 My Will and desire is that my Niece Ann Sandy and my two friends Wm

17. Give to Joseph Sutton son of my friend Richard Sutton Thirty Shillings bank money
18. My Will and desire is that my two Sisters Anne and Tom should have liberty to choose who they would live with amongst my Kinred after my Death
19. My Will and desire is that my wearing clothes should be equally Divided betwixt my Niece Ann Sandy and my niece Betty Spruce and my Niece Mary Sandy
20. My Will and desire is that my Niece Ann Sandy and my two friends William Templeman and Richard Hutson Templeman should have the care of Margaret Templemans Estate till she come to the age of Eighteen years or Married Except my Niece Betty Spruce should choose to be a Widow and then for her to have liberty to live on that Estate with her Daughter during her Widowhood and no longer
21. I Give and bequeath to my Niece Ann Sandy all the Remainder part of my Estate of House Goods and Stock &c
22. My Will and desire is that my Niece Ann Sandy be Sole and Sole Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament making Void all former Wills made or spoken of by me the Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 14th day of July 1764.
23. My Will and desire is that no part of my Estate should be offered
