and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form following
that is to say first and principally I bequeath my Soul to God that governeth
my Body to the Parish to be decently buried in a Christian like manner at the
discretion of my Executors hereafter named Viz. first I give and bequeath to my
well beloved Wife my Negroes whose names are Saml. Hannah Guy and Peggy
during her life or until I give and bequeath to my Son William Bragg my
Negro boy named Joe and my Will and after his Mothers death to have the
above Saml and Hannah to him and his heirs forever. Then I give and bequeath
to my Son James Bragg my Negro Boy and Girl named Harry and Winny
with her increase except the first Child named Jane to him and his heirs forever.

Then I give and bequeath to my Son Matthew Bragg the Vine of Land that I
bought of Capt George P and all also my Negro Boy and Girl named George
and Pegg with her increase except her first Child named Sibbie to him and his
heirs forever. Then I give to my Daughter Rebecca Bragg my Negro Girls
Milly and the above Jane with their Increase forever.

And I give to my daughter Anne Bragg my Negro-Girl Beti and therefore
Sole with these words forever I am I give and bequeath to my Grandson William
H. Bragg my negro Boy called Guy to him and his heirs forever. I am my Will
and date is that after my Wife's death my whole Estate should be sold and equally
divided amongst my five Children William Bragg Rebecca Bragg James
Bragg, John Bragg and Matthew Bragg and I do also make and ordain
my well beloved Wife and William Bragg my whole Executors and Executors
this my last Will and Testament. Revoking and Disannulling all the Wills and
Testaments by me heretofore made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
affixed my Seal this Twentieth day of August 1788.
