do make & declare this my last will and Testament in manner following
Imps my will is that all my Just debts be paid & discharged by my Exors hereafter.
Item I give to my Sister Mully Miskell my Riding Horse
Item it is my Will and desire that all the Rest of my Estate of what kind soever
be Equally divided Between my Sister Mully Miskell & my Cousin George Miskell
but in case my said Sister Mully should die without Lawfull issue of her Body

then give him part to my said Cousin George and his heirs for ever
 I do hereby constitute my Friends John Spurr George Miskell & Joseph Wood
 Executors of this my last will and Testament Witness my hand & Seal this
 14th day of July 1789
