at the Discretion of Ex^{rs} hereafter named nothing Doubting but at
the General Resurrection to receive the same by the power of God
and as touching my Worldly Estate whosoever with God hath bestowed on me in
this life I Give and Dispose of the same as followeth -

Item I Give and bequeath y^e to my Dear and Loving Wife Mary Fowler
all my personal Estate except three mares I give to my three Daughters
hereafter named -

Item I Give to my Daughter Mary Fowler a young mare of three years old
I Give to my Daughter Elizabeth Fowler a mare of two years old
I Give to my Daughter Martha Fowler a mare of four years My Will is
y^t my three Daughters afores^d have the s^d mares paid to them at the
age of Sixteen by my Wife Mary Fowler - - -

Item I Give to my Son David Fowler the plantation my Brother in Law
Robert Knolds now lives on and to have it in his possession at the age
of Sixteen to him and heirs for ever - - -

Item My Will is y^t if the Childrens Wife now goes with her a bay and

Give y^e then good the plantation I now live on to him after my wife's
Deces to him and his heirs for ever - - -

Item - My Will is that if my wife lives longer than myselfe y^t at her Deces all
my personal Estate be equally divided between my Children
I doe ordaine this to be my last Will and Testament and do appoint my
Dear and Loving Wife Mary Fowler my heire and sole Ex^r after my
last Dying and Dismissing all other Wills heretofore made by me
Relifing and Confirming this to be my last Will and Testament and none
other In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and fixed my
seal this 2^d of January 1774 -
