I give to be Equally divided among all my children including that Child she is now
pregnant with. Item I give & bequeath to my son William Mitchell one negro
Gent named Dick to have & to have upon condition that he the said William shall
buriall my other Children negroes to be kept on his Land till they come to the
age of twenty one years. Item I give & bequeath all the rest of my Negroes to be
Equally divided among all my Children including that child my wife is now

Bequest my other Childrens requires to be made on his Bond till they come to the
age of Twenty one years. I also Give & bequeath all the rest of my Estate to be
Equally divided amongst all my Children including that child who is now born with
with when they come to the age of Twenty one years. I also Give & bequeath that
all my stock of every kind & household goods shall be equally divided between
my Loving wife & all my Children including that child who is now born with.
I also Give & bequeath to appoint my Loving wife Hannah Mitchell wife
my Brother Richard Mitchell & Anne Trenchard Executors of this my Last will &
Testament executing & discharging all & every other business made by me under
the Testimony of my hand & Seal this second day of January One Thousand
Seven hundred and Fifty Eight.
