Maintenance out of the profits of my Estate to be Equally born by my
Two Sons

Item I Give to W^m Swannah Webb forty Shillings a year out of the profits
of my Estate as long as she Lives with her Aunt Mrs Betty Webb &
aparts her in the Care & Affairs of My family & Estate

Item All my other Estates of What Nature or kind I Give & Bequeath
to my two Sons Robert & Walker to be Equally divided between them
