1st I Give and bequeath unto my Sister Winifred Effers one Cow and grating and all my
hags also my Father's bed and furniture Likewise I Give and bequeath my said
Sister Winifred Forty acres of land in the aforesaid County of Richmond adjoining
Richards of plots Lane and the Lesigne one A morning part of my Land I Give
and bequeath unto my brother William Algon
Lastly I constitute and appoint my loving friend John Effers my whole
and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament Resolving hereby all Friends
and other Willing Witnesses whom I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
23 day of June among Friends 1764

and bequeath unto my brother William Alger
Lastly I constitute and appoint my loving friend John Offord my whole
and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament Revoking hereby all former
and other Wills by me made whereof I have unto set my hand and seal this
23rd day of June anno domini 1764
