

In the name of God amen I Sarah Crask of the Parish Lunenburg &
County of Richmond being weak in Body but of a perfect sound mind and memory thanks
be to God therefore willing to meet the dangers of this Transitory life do make and ordain
this my last Will and Testament, Viz^d first I give my Soul to God who gave it me & my
Body to be buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter named, in a decent and
Christian like manner & then that all my lawful debts be paid &c. and after so done, the
balance of what worldly Estate the Lord hath been pleased to bless me with, I do will, bequeath
and dispose of in the manner and form as follows —

Here I give and bequeath unto my son John Crask one Yoke of Steers, two Cows, two breeding
hens, two Cows & twelve pounds specie to be delivered immediately after my decease to him and
his heirs forever —

Here I give and bequeath unto my youngest son James Crask all the remaining part of my
Estate and for him to be possessed with it immediately after my decease to him and his
heirs forever, but provided he my said son James Crask should decease under the age of
21 years I do will that the said James Crask should have and hold the said Estate to be Equally

and dispose of in the manner and form as follows -

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Jesse Crank one York of Steers, two Cows, two breeding
hens, two Eggs, & such personal effects to be delivered immediately after my decease to him and
his heirs forever -

Item I give and bequeath unto my youngest son James Crank all the remaining part of my
Estate and for him to be possessed with it immediately after my decease to him and his
heirs forever, but provided he my said son James Crank should decease under the age of
twenty one years leaving no lawful heir that then for what I have given him to be Equally
divided between his Brother Vincent Crank and Jesse Crank, one to have as much as the other
Item Lastly I do nominate and appoint Vincent Crank and Jesse Crank my true and lawful
executors of this my last Will and Testament, Revoking every other Will or Wills made by me heretofore
Witness my hand and Seal, this 1st day of December one thousand, seven hundred and twenty

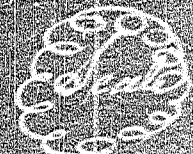
