Will I give & bequeath unto my Son Simon Miller all my Land from y^e
River to y^e School house Swamp with y^e two Plantations and all
improvements thereon to my Son & y^e Heirs of his Body for ever
and in failure of such Heirs I give y^e aforesaid Land with all y^e improvements
thereon to my Daughter Jane Miller & to her Heirs for ever.

I give & bequeath unto my Son Simon Miller all my Land from y^e
River to y^e School house Swamp with y^e two Plantations and all
improvements thereon to my Son & y^e Heirs of his Body for ever
and in failure of such Heirs I give y^e aforesaid Land with all y^e improvements
thereon to my Daughter Jane Miller & to her Heirs for ever.

I give & bequeath unto my Son Simon Miller all my Land from y^e
River to y^e School house Swamp with y^e two Plantations and all
improvements thereon to my Son & y^e Heirs of his Body for ever
and in failure of such Heirs I give y^e aforesaid Land with all y^e improvements
thereon to my Daughter Jane Miller & to her Heirs for ever.

Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Eleanora Miller all my Land on y^e back side of y^e School house Swamp inclusive of y^e Swamp with the Plantation thereon & all y^e appurtenances to her y^e Eleanora Miller & to her heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath to my afores^d Daughters Eleanora & Jane Miller to each of them a French an Iron Pot & to my Daughter Jane a Roll Mill & Skillet & to my Daughter Eleanora a large Skillet & a Gallon Pewther Basin.

Item I give & bequeath to my afores^d Son Simon Miller all y^e rest of my personal Efforts whate so ever he paying what Debts I owe and also paying to my Daughter Jane Miller y^e sum of Thirty Pound Sterlⁿ money at y^e day of her Marriage or when she shall arrive at y^e Age of two & twenty Years.

Item I give to my s^d Daughter Jane Miller Thirty Pounds Sterlⁿ money as over to be paid as afores^d.

Item My Will is that my Son Simon Miller shall be at Age to choose his Guardian when he shall arrive at y^e Age of sixteen Years.

Item My Will is that my Exorut^r hereafter mentioned doe give my s^d Son Simon two Years & a half Schooling to read write & cast Acc^t.

Item My Will is that my Exorut^r hereafter mentioned doe keep my Plantation in good Repair till my s^d Son Simon shall arrive at y^e Age of sixteen Years.

Lastly I doe leave my Daughter Eleanora Miller & William Smith that live in my House joint Exorut^r of this my last Will & Testament. And my Will is that y^e s^d William Smith shall have his Accomodations & Fuel & Service as at my now dwelling Plantation untill my s^d Son

Item. My Will is that my Son Simon Miller shall be at Age to choose his
Guardian when he shall arrive at y^e Age of Sixteen Years. —

Item. My Will is that my Execut: hereafter mentioned doe give my s^r Son
Simon two Years & a half Schooling to read write & cast Acc: —

Item. My Will is that my Execut: hereafter mentioned doe keep my Plantation
in good Repair till my s^r Son Simon shall arrive at y^e Age of Sixteen Years.

Lastly. I doe leave my Daughter Eleonore Miller & William Smith that
live in my House joint Execut: of this my last Will & Testament.
and my Will is that if s^r William Smith shall have his Accomodation
Diet & Lodging clear at my now dwelling Plantation untill my s^r Son
Simon shall arrive at y^e Age of Sixteen Years for keeping y^e Plantation
in Repair & taking Care of y^e Stock and I doe hereby revoke all
other Wills & Testam: by me heretofore made. In Witness whereof
