to to of Earth to be buried in Christian manner at the discretion of my Ex^{ors}
hereafter named there to be paid a lawful & convenient charge the one
of J. B. Bryan & his heirs for what Mortally Estate it shall please God to
bestow upon me I dispose of as follows

Impr:

- I Will that all my Debts be paid and funeral Charges be & of my Son
I am I Will and Bequeath all my Estate to my Son Thomas Bryan (Receiving
of use of J. Bryan with the appurtenances to my well beloved Wife Elleanor
during her natural life) and the Heirs of his Body and for want of such Heirs
I remain to my Grand Son Geo. Bryan alias Heirs of Geo. Bryan's Son
John to have and his heirs forever.
- I am I Will and Bequeath to my beloved Wife Elleanor a Gray Mare
branded with MB and now in possession of Hugh McCay and her Heirs.
- I am I Give to my Son John a Cow Two Shilling.
- I am I Give to my Daughter Winifred McCay One Shilling.
- I am I Give to my Daughter Margaret Bryan One Shilling.
- I am I Give and Bequeath all & residue of my Personal Estate to be Equally
divided between my above Wife and two Youngest Children viz Geo. &
Constitute as my Wife above & my sole Ex^{ors} Revoking all Wills & Testaments
by me heretofore made Ratifying and Confirming this to be my Last Will &
Testament to Witness my hand this 26th of Octob^r Anno Domⁱ 1767
