at the discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned.

And for what Watch God so it hath pleased God to bless me with I give
& bequeath in full worth viz. I give & bequeath to my loving Brother
Henry Fitzhugh all my Books.

Item. I give and bequeath to my loving Brother George Fitzhugh my great
Wife's Linen and my Silver Chappellet &c.

Item. I give and bequeath to my loving Brother John Fitzhugh my Silver Plates.

Item. I give & bequeath to my friend Mr. James Green his choice of my Silver Watch &c.

Item. I give & bequeath to my friend Mr. Fuller a new Suit of Cloaths I had made
to go down to Town.

Item. It is my Will & desire that what Debts I owe may be paid out of my Personal
Estate after the above Legacies are set apart. And if my Personal Estate
be not sufficient to pay all my said Debts then I charge that if any of my
said Executors or other mentioned do sell such of my Negroes as they shall
think fit to pay y^e same.

Item. Whereas I owe Money to several y^e poor in New England which hath bin due

at the discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned.

And for what Most Holy Good it hath pleased God to bless me with, I give & bequeath in fullness of heart, I give & bequeath to my loving Brother -
Henry Fitzhugh all my Books.

Item I give and bequeath to my loving Brother George Fitzhugh my great
Wings Smoker and my Silver Chagualat Lute.

Item I give all my ~~other~~ my Brother John Fitzhugh two Silver Plates.

Item I give & bequeath to my friend Mr. James Green his choice of my Silver Watches.

Item I give & bequeath to my friend Mr. Butler a new Suit of Cloaths I had made
to go down to Town.

Item It is my Will & desire that what Debt I owe may be paid out of my Personal
Estate & if the above Legacies are not paid, then my Personal Estate
be not sufficient to pay all my said Debt, then I leave it at the discretion of
my Executors hereafter mentioned to sell such of my Negroes as they shall
think fit to pay if some.

Item Whereas I owe to many several Persons in New England which hath bin a
considerable time, it is my Will & desire if my Executors hereafter mentioned
as soon as conveniently they can after my decease may give my Creditors
tho' Notice that they may improve some body here to receive such of my
Debt as shall appear to be justly due, And whereas I am only oblig'd to pay
the said Debt in Money according to if New England Currency, yet in
consideration of their having stay'd so long for their Money and in law and
full satisfaction of any Interest they may demand for if same, I leave it
to pay in Sterling Money of England, and for if immediate raising by some

I have it wholly to y^e affection of my Executors to sell in part my Estate
with a small portion of my land as they shall think fit.

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Fitzhugh all that part
of my Estate both Land & Tenement which my said Daughter
fully entitled to by her parents and I have as a full discharge of the value
of the above Legacy I give her y^e third third part of an Estate which
I full satisfaction of her will of my said Daughter Mary Fitzhugh
that she part of that is common of my said Daughter Mary Fitzhugh to her
heirs for ever the 3rd part of my said Daughter Mary Fitzhugh to her
directly the third part of my said Daughter Mary Fitzhugh to her heirs
then and their Executors to my Daughter Mary Fitzhugh & her heirs
of her Body lawfully begotten & if she die without such heirs
then to my Brother Henry Fitzhugh & if he die of his Body lawfully
begotten & for want of such heirs to my Brother George Fitzhugh
& the heirs of his Body lawfully begotten & for want of such heirs
to my Brother John Fitzhugh & his heirs.

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Fitzhugh all y^e remaining
part of my Estate after my Debt & Legacies are paid my said Daughter is
already entitled to by my will. I leave it to her & her heirs
and Executors to have and hold the remaining part of my said Daughter Mary
to her & her heirs of her Body lawfully begotten & for want of such
heirs to my Brother Henry Fitzhugh & the heirs of his Body
lawfully begotten & for want of such heirs to my Brother George
Fitzhugh & the heirs of his Body lawfully begotten & for want of such
heirs to my Brother John Fitzhugh and his heirs for ever.

Item I will & Ordain y^e my loving Brother Henry Fitzhugh have y^e care
& direction of my said Daughter Mary Fitzhugh & her heirs.
