one Thousand Seven hundred and Sixty two, I Thomas Lyn of the
Parish of Lunenburg and County of Richmond being very Sick and
weak of body but of perfect and sound mind and memory thank to
God therefore, calling to mind the Mortality of my body and knowing
that it is appointed for all men once to die Do make and ordain this
my last Will and Testament that is to say first I bequeath my

Soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it and my body to the Earth
to be buried in a Decent manner at the Discretion of my Executors hereof
two names and as Touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath
pleased God to bless me in this Life: I Give, Devise, and Dispose thereof
in manner and form following
I Give and bequeath unto my son Robert Lynne All the plantation
and Land thereunto belonging wherem I now Live or shall hereinafter
and his heirs Lawfully begotten of his body forever and for ever such
heirs to I send to my Son Thomas Lynne and his heirs Lawfully
begotten of his body forever hereundering one Half of the said plantation
and Land to my well beloved Wife Mary Lynne during her Widowhood
without Interruption or Molestation of either of my said Sons
I Give and bequeath unto said Robert one negro man named Ann
one to be Delivered unto him at the age of Twenty one years (and My said
Wife to have the use of the said Negro till the said Twenty two years
Expire) Together with all and singular my Smiths Tools
I Give and bequeath unto my son Thomas Lynne all and singular
the Land and plantations which Purchased of Henry Haughes

together with all and singular my lands and tenements
I Give and bequeath unto my son Thomas Lynne all and singular
the Lands and plantations which I purchased of Henry Haughes
George Wells and James Irkinis to him and his heirs forever
Lawfully begotten of his body and for want of such heirs to Descend
to my said son James and his heirs forever. Reserving one half thereof
for the use of my said Wife during her Widowhood as before heited.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my said son Thomas one negro boy named
Jouren.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my said son James Lynne All that Tract
of Land which I agreed for to purchase of Henry Willson and the said
Land to be paid for out of my Estate; Together with one negro woman
named Dinah and her Increase to him and his heirs forever.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Susanna All one negro
Girl named Grace.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my two daughters Mary and Bathia
Lynne one negro woman named Winny and her child named Abiah
born and the said negro woman's future Increase till my said daughter
Bathia shall arrive to the age of fifteen years of age at which time

WM I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Susanna All the one negro Girl named Grace.

WM I Give and bequeath unto my two daughters Mary and Bathia Lynne one negro woman named Wincy and her child named Abraham and the said negro woman's future Increase till my said Daughter Bathia shall arrive to the age of fifteen years of age at which time my Will is that there shall be a Division of the said Increase that the shall live Equally between my said two daughters. Reserving the use of the said negro woman to my Wife during her Natural Life.

WM I Give unto my Daughter Mary one Father Bed and furniture such as my Wife shall see fit to deliver her at Marriage.

WM I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Anne Lynne one Girl named Kips.

WM I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth one Negro Girl named Anna.

WM My Will is that all and singular the Residue and Remaining part of my Estate both Slave and other Personal Estate to be Equally Divided among all my Children that are living at my wife's death.

Desire Reserving the use of it to My beloved Wife During her natural
Life for the Support and maintenance of my Children
Lastly I do constitute appoint and ordain my beloved Wife and my Son
Robert Executors and Executors of this my last Will and Testament
Revoking and Disannulling all other former Wills, Legacies and
Bequests by me heretofore written, Left and signed this Ratifying
and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament
