do make and Appoint this to be my last Will and Testament first I Recommend
my Soul to God and my Body to the Earth and as to my Worldly Goods I give &
dispose of in manner following.

I give and Bequeath to my Son William Jackson my Negroes Luke
Christof Mawson Luke Lucy Frank James Mary, Mary Waller Easter Henry
Jany Pomer Tom Lady Thaddus Dinah, Little Hannah Mary Patt
He and Youngest Child Which I give to him and his Heirs forever
I also give to my Son William One Hundred pounds Current Money.
Item My Lands and Plantations and all the Rest of my Estate of what kind
soever I desire may be equally divided between John Vincent Tom & Betty being
the four Children of Elizabeth All good which I give to them and their heirs
forever.

I do hereby appoint Elizabeth Allgood my Executive of this my last Will and
Testament in writing whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this Eleventh
day of December 1791
