Testament in manner and forme following.

I bequeath my Soul to God who gave it and my body to be buried, as my Ex^{ts} hereafter
named shall think fit.

Item. - I Give unto my daughter Mary Leach one Ring of fifteen Shill: price.

Item. - I Give to my daughter Susan Barber fifteen hundred yd of cloth.

Item. - I Give to my Son John Barber my bay horse Diamonds.

Item. - I Give to Sam^l Wood a horse or Mare of three years old, the Saddle and bridle which
is now at J^r: Milners belonging to me the bed and furniture which he now lies on.

Item. - I Give to Mary Wood a Young horse or Mare of three years old and a fine saddle
of about thirty Shill: price.

Item. - I Give to my daughter Joyce my Negro Boys Tony and Tom One feather bed and
furniture three Cows and three Calves five Ewes and a Ram.

Item. - I Give to my daughter Ann my Negro Boy Harry and Negro Girl Mary One
feather bed and furniture three Cows and three Calves five Ewes and a Ram.

Item. - I Give to my two daughters Joyce and Ann and their he^y for ever equally to
be Divided all my Land in Giltensburge Dist^{ct}.

Item. - I Give unto my Loving wife my two Negroes Jack and Josh, the One half of
my Mill during her life my Riding horse.

Item. - I Give to my Son Sam^l my Negroes Tom Kate Robin and the Negro Sam^l -
Saidly I stand Indebted to me and that he be of age to take his estate in his

Item. I give unto my good and lawfull loving Son Sam^l my Mill during her Life my Riding horse.

Item. I Give to my Son Sam^l my Negroes Tom Late John and the Negro Sam^l Bayly Stander Indebted to me and that he be of age to take his estate in his hands when he is Eighteen years old.

Item. I Give to my said Son Sam^l the other halfe of my Mill and after his mothers death to have her all.

Item. I Give to my Son Sam^l my Grey horse Squerrell.

Item. I do nominate and appoint my loving Wife and my Son Sam^l my whole and sole Exors of this my Last will and Testament and do Give them all the rest of my estate.

Item. It is my desire y^t my Brother Charles Barber and my Cousin John Farpley be as Trustees to See my said will performed In Wit^h whereof I have herunto set my hand and fixed my Seal this 10th day of March 1729.
