And forgiveness of all my sins I do inherit Everlasting life & my body
Commit to the earth to be Decently Buried at the discretion of my
Executors hereafter named touching the disposition of all such
Temporal Estate as it hath Pleased Almighty God to bestow upon me
I Give & dispose thereof as followeth first I will that my Debt shall
Be paid & discharged from my Give unto my son Joshua harper one Shilling
Sterling & no More from my Give unto my daughter Mary Caverton one
Shilling Sterling & no More from my Give unto my daughter Sarah
harper one Shilling Sterling & no More from my Give unto my daughter
Hannah harper the Bed & furniture now in use & all the Rest of my
Estate I will to my Wife Elizabeth harper During her Widowhood &
after her Marriage or decease to be Equally divided between my Children
Hereafter named William harper Daniel harper George harper

James harper. I Leave my Loving Wife Elizabeth harper & my son
