son Charles Jones till he arrive to the age of twenty one years

Item I desire the Chest of my house and maner to be sold towards Discharging
my Debts &c Item my desired in the remainder Part of my Estate after
my Just debts paid to Remain in my wifes hand During her widowhood
and after to be Equally Divided between her and all my Children

Item I appoint William Garland and Bradley Garner Soners &c my wife
Executors of this my last will and Testament in respect my hand and seal

Then I desire my largest young mare to be sold and the money kept for my son Charles Jones till he arrive to the age of twentyone years.

From I desire the Best of my horses and manes to be sold for cash Discharging
my Debt &c. From my desire is the remainder Part of my Estate of Realty
my Just debt paid to Remain in my wife's hand During her widowhood
and after to be Equally Divided between her and all my Children.

I then appointed William Garland and Bradley Garner Honors Executors of this my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this sixth day of October one thousand seven hundred and fifty eight

of sound and perfect sense thanks be given to god for it therefore calling
to mind the mortality of my body well knowing that all that are born
must die do make and obtain this to be my last will and testament
that is to say Principally and first of all I bequeath my soul into
the hands of god that gave it me and my body I commit to the Earth
to be Buried in Christian like and decent manner and as for such
Worldly Estate wherewith god has been pleased to bless me with in
this world I give devise and dispose of the same in manner and
form following I give to my well beloved William one half
the sum of £ 400
