Give him my Stillards and give to him and his heirs forever -

I Give my son Joshua a large Diaper Table Cloth -

I Likewise Give my son Joshua five silver plates two silver
Basons a brass Skillet with a frame, two iron pots to him & his heirs forever -

I Likewise Give my son Joshua One Man's Bridle and Saddle to him and his
heirs forever -

Item, I lend to my Loving wife Ann two Feather Beds and furniture During her

Item, I lend to my Loving Wife Ann two Ironers beds and furniture During her life or Widowhood and no longer, And at her Death or Marriage to return to my son Joshua. I likewise lend the use of my Negro Wench to my Wife, also five Dishes and nine plates, three iron pots one trunk and chest One mare Bridle and Saddle one Knife, Kettle & a Skillet, one Spice mortar and pestle During her life or Widowhood and no longer And then to return to the Benefit of my son Joshua, I likewise give her two table cloths in the same manner.

Item, I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Brumby one Cow and calf. —
I Desire that all the rest of my Estate be Equally Divided between my son Joshua and my Wife Ann, My will and meaning is that she should have the use of what I've left her During her life or Widowhood, But no longer, And then to return to the use and Benefit of my son Joshua And I nominally appoint my Loving Wife Ann Executrix and my son Joshua Executor of this my last will and Testament Revoking & Disannulling all other Wills made by me heretofore in Testimony I have hereunto set my hand
