

I In the name of God Amen I William Howard of Richmond
County and Parish of North Farnham being well stricken in Years and in
a lost State of Health; being in sound Sense and Memory blessed be God
for it do make this my last Will and Testament; in manner and form
following. First and principally I Bequeath my Soul to Almighty
God that first gave it me; trusting to the Merits of my sweet Saviour
Jesus that at the general Resurrection I shall receive Pardon and
Remission of all my Sins, and my Body to be buried in a decent
and a Christian like manner by my Executors hereafter mentioned; and as
for Worldly Goods, that it hath pleased Almighty God to endue
me with I give as followeth.

Item I give and bequeath to my Grand Son George Morise Howard
one Hundred Acres of Land that I bought of George Wallis
to be possessed with it when he shall arrive to y^e age of Twenty One
Years to him and his lawful Heirs forever and if he should
die before he is possessed with the said Land my Will is that y^e
said Hundred Acres of Land shall belong to my Son William
Howard or his Heirs to them and their Heirs forever.

Item I give to my Grand Son William Howard my common Prayer Book

Item I give to my Grand Son William For after my common prayer Book
that was Mr. Fathers.

Item I give to my Grand daughter Nancy Davenport my Negro
Boy Josiah during her life, and after her Death my Will is that
her Son William Hole shall have the said Negro Boy to them
and their Heirs forever.

Item I give unto my Son William Monum all the remainder part of
my of my Land to him and his Heirs forever I also give him my
young bay Mare and my Gun.

Item I give unto Nancy Campbell that Woman's Saddle her mother had
Item My Will is that my whole Estate that hath not been before given
may equally be divided in Three Parts and my Son William
Monum to have his choice the two other parts to be sold
and the money arising therefrom to be equally divided between
my Son Georges Monum three Children or the Survivors of them
and Betty Campbells three Children or the Survivors of them

Lastly I do constitute ordain and appoint my Son William Monum
Executor of my last Will and Testament.
