Sick & Weak in Body, but of perfect mind Minding thanks be to God for the Same, do make and ordain to  
my last Will and Testament, and what worldly Goods it hath pleased God to induce me with after my  
Debts are paid, &c. I dispose of in manner & form following Viz<sup>t</sup> I give my Soul in the hands of God from  
whence it came and my body I leave to be buried at the discretion of my Ex<sup>ors</sup> hereafter Mentioned  
Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Betty Efford all my land during her Natural life, & if  
she marries and if she Marries my Desire is that she shall be thundred, by my Ex<sup>ors</sup> and the land to  
be Rented for the Support of my Children, my Desire is at the death of my Wife, or when my Son  
John Efford comes to the Age of twenty one years that my land shall be equally divided between my  
three Sons, George, Zachariah & John Efford, & if either of them should die it is my desire that it shall  
be divided between the two living, it is further my Desire, that my Sons pay unto my Daughter Pe-  
lly Efford the sum of three pounds Annually untill they pay her an Equally proportionable part  
of my Land, my Desire is that all the rest my Estate to be equally divided, Between My four Children  
Above Mentioned — I leave George Miskell & George Martin to be my whole Ex<sup>ors</sup> whereas  
to I set my hand & seal this 16 day of April 1792
