

1. In the name of God amen. I Elias Pembaker of the County and State of Va being of feeble health and conscious of the brevity of human life, but being of sound mind and disposing memory, do make and ordain this my last will and Testament, here by revoking all the Wills heretofore made. It is my will to make the following disposition of my worldly estate.

1st I direct that all my just debts due at my decease and my funeral expense to be paid by my executor hereinafter named or the survivor of them, out of my Estate as soon after my decease as to them may seem convenient.

2nd I direct that my executors retain fifteen hundred dollars out of my estate, for the benefit of my wife Susan, of said amount and the interest there from. She is to receive not exceeding one hundred and fifty dollars per year for her support &c. during her widowhood or life time.

3rd I also direct that my wife Susan has the privilege of retaining for for her own use any article, what ever she may want of the household property. I also direct that my wife has the privilege to retain one horse and rockaway for her own use.

4th I direct that after the marriage or decease of wife, if any of the money or property is not disposed of by her that my executors sell the property and divide the proceeds equally between my children.

5th It is my will that the foregoing provisions I have made for my wife Susan, shall be in place of her dower in my estate.

6th I direct my executors shall make deeds to my son Joseph E. Pembaker and my Son-in-law Wm Deaton and Mary M. Deaton his wife when the whole amount of purchase money is paid for the lands I have sold them.

7th I direct that at my decease that my son Emory W. Pembaker is to have my home place on Meadown road where I now live, for the sum of Four thousand dollars. one third cash. The remaining two thirds in two equal annual payments one & two years without interest. When purchase money is paid I direct my executors to make him a deed for the said place.

8th If I do not sell in my life time my place on the Greenridge containing 73 a more or less, I direct that my executors sell the place after my decease to the highest bidder, on such terms as they think best and make a deed to the said land when all the purchase money is paid.

9th It is my will that the proceeds of my estate be

divided equally between my children.

10th I hereby appoint my son Joseph, E. Embaker and H. A. Eiler my executors of this my last will and Testament, to settle up all business I may leave unsettled at my decease.

11th I do not require my Executors to give securities as to will.

12th I hereby reserve two rooms in the house I now live in for the use of my wife Susan after my decease if she wishes to reside there during her life.
