

or six, are now Jane between three & four, at the time they went to live with him. For some two or three year past, the boy Fletcher has been able to render considerable service, and his services have probably been equivalent to his maintenance.

The girls have not been able to render any material assistance in his family. It is however, probable, that for the last four or five years, they may be supposed on an average to have earned their support. I have concluded, upon the whole, that the sum allowed for Boarding<sup>r</sup> is a very reasonable and moderate one.
