The Guardian represents that he board & clothed
his Ward from September 1836 to the present time,
except that one of them, Artemisia, has been living
else where for about a year past. He states that the
eldest, Rhoda, was about eight or nine years of
age. Minnera about seven, Artemisia about five.

or six, and Am Jan between three & four, at the time they went to live with him. For some two or three years past, the boy Rhodon has been able to render considerable service, and his service has probably been equivalent to his maintenance.

The girls have not been able to render any special assistance in his family. It is, however, probable, that for the last four or five years, they may be supposed on an average to have earned their support. I have concluded, upon the whole, that the sum allowed for Boarding is a very reasonable and moderate one.
