Maria by our father John Withers deceased, after her  
death I devise the said interest therein to my said  
niece Laura J Campbell -

I appoint Richard T Campbell Exor of this my  
last will & testament and direct that he be  
allowed to qualify as such without giving  
security and I further direct that there be  
no appraisement of my estate
