dispose of all my wooly Estate, first after after my death I
desire that all my just debts if any there may be, with my
funeral expenses be paid out of any property Real or personal
2nd I give and bequeath to my two grand Nephews John N.
Jones & William St. Jones. Sons of my Niece Nancy St. Jones.
formerly Nancy St. Goff. all my Real & personal Estate for
which they are to keep and maintain me during my
life time, also my Niece Nancy St. Jones, as long as
she may live. I deem it unnecessary to appoint any
Executor to this my last Will and Testament hereby
revoking all other former Will or Testaments by me
heretofore made in witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my seal this 2nd day of May
1885.
