

Wm D Bryant

I William D. Bryant being of a sound mind and memory, made this, my last will and testament as follows. viz

1st. I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved wife, Mary C. Bryant all of my property both real and personal, consisting of the house and lot on Franklin Road near Roanoke City, adjoining Crystal Spring Land Co, Joseph Bryant's ranch containing six acres more or less and lying in Roanoke County, Virginia and also all of my personal property consisting of 1 horse and all cattle and stock whatever which I may own at my death and all household and kitchen furniture and all other property of which I may die seized to have and to hold so long as she may live.

2nd. I desire that my beloved wife give to my daughter Mary M. Bryant (\$5) Fifty dollars near the date of her marriage
 & 3rd. I desire that the Bryant Estate be for ever reserved to the use of the Bryant family

4th. after the death of my beloved wife I desire that all of the property be equally divided among my children.

I desire that the law protect my beloved wife in the peaceable possession of the above named property.

I hereby appoint my beloved wife as my executrix, without security and desire that my whole estate be placed in her hands at my death to hold so long as she may live.

In witness whereof I William D. Bryant have to this my last will and testament, subscribed my name and affixed my seal this 12 day of April 1902 at near Roanoke,

The last will & testament of Wm D. Bryant deceased was this day produced in Court, and proved according to law by the oath of J.M. Smith, one of the subscribing witnesses thereto, and is ordered to be recorded, and on motion of Mrs Mary C. Bryant, the executrix therein named, who made oath thereto (no security being required under said will) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150⁰⁰) conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted her for obtaining a probate of said will in due form.
