 give and bequeath to my ^{Daughter} Polly a good horse saddle and two cows
 I also give and bequeath to my daughter Rachel one good horse
 saddle and two cows I likewise give and bequeath to my daughter
~~Fanny one good horse saddle and two cows~~ I also give and bequeath
 to my daughter Betsy one good horse saddle and two cows in case
 my wife should marry her part of the lands to be equally divided
 among my sons and no more of the movable property at her disposal
 but ~~that was mentioned above~~ I ordain that the Executors shall sell
 the land when they think it will be most advantageous for my
 family I appoint my wife Nancy M. Campbell James
 Telford and William Anderson my Executors And I make
 and declare this to my last will and Testament witnessing all

former Testaments made by me and to which I set my hand and
sent this nineteenth day of January one thousand seven hundred
