give and bequeath to my Polly a good horse saddle and two cows

I also give and bequeath to my daughter Rachel one good horse

saddle and two cows I likewise give and bequeath to my daughter

Jessie one good horse saddle and two cows I also give and bequeath

to my daughter Betty one good horse saddle and two cows in case

my wife should die any less part of the land is to be equally divided

among my sons and the more of the movable property at her disposal

but what was mentioned above I desire that the executors shall sell

the land where they think it will be most advantageous for my

family I appoint my wife Nancy McCampbell James

Selina and William Anderson my executors - *Child Justice*
