queeth to my son David, my Bay mare and ^{his} Black horse now in ^{his} possession, and
Ike wise the price of a horse sold to my son James, Prior to this date, with my
Right to all my movable property, out of which he is to pay to my Daughter
Margret, my son Andrew and my Daughter Marthaw, the sum of ten Dollars to
Each. I do hereby appoint my son David and Andrew Eloyes, to be the Executors
of this my last will and Testament Given under my hand and seal this
