wife and two youngest sons but if he chooses not to take it it
must be sold to pay them. I also allow my son William ten
pounds which said money he has now in possession. I do also allow
my daughter Elizabeth one twenty pounds bond on George Suffer
one in year if our Lord one thousand eight hundred & five

I do also nominate my wife Jane and my son Robert as
