In the Fearre of God I John Weir  
of the State of Virginia & County of Rockbridge being in  
health of body and in perfect mind and memory but  
calling to minde the mortality of my body and the obliga-  
tion I am under to order my estate in the best manner  
I am capable to do Justice to my wife and Children do Con-  
stitute and ordain this my last will and Testament and  
ordain and appoint my whole estate to be distributed  
in the following manner Viz I order that all my just  
debt

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With be discharged next I will and bequeath to my beloved wife  
Mary Weir the full thirds of all my personal or moveable estate  
to be disposed of at her pleasure likewise the third of my Lands dur-  
ing her natural life likewise I give and bequeath to my son  
John Weir to him his heirs and assigns forever a full right and  
title to all my lands except what is above reserved or shall be after  
reserved in this will upon Conditions he shall pay unto my two  
daughters Polly & Nancy Weir the sum of one hundred pounds  
to each of them in the following manner one year after my  
decease he shall pay the sum of twenty pounds ten pounds to each  
of them & annually the same until the above sum of one hundred  
pounds is paid to each of them My Household and other fur-  
niture I order to be equally divided between my wife and my

two daughters Polly & Mary likewise I order that be an equal  
divide of my Horses Cows & Sheep between my aforesaid daughters and  
their beds and furniture with their saddles and bridles and also if  
they should remain unmarried one or both of them I reserve the  
sole privilege of my dwelling house and a garden not exceeding  
five pole square likewise pasture for two Horses in common with  
other Horses on the farm & also I order that my son John  
furnish ground and sow one half acre in flax annually  
for them while they remain unmarried. The remaining  
part of my invincible estate not expressed above I order to fall  
to my son John. Lastly I appoint Hugh Weir & James Houston  
my Executors and hereby revoke and disannull all former  
wills & Testaments made by me. In Witness whereof I
