 able estate to dispose of as she thinks proper by Will or
 otherwise also I give and bequeath unto my dear wife Sarah
 Moore during her natural life the third part of the planta-
 tion I now live on lying on the waters of Buffalo Creek
 in the said County of Rockbridge. Then I give and
 bequeath unto my ^{two} sons William Moore and Samuel Moore
 the two thirds of the plantation I now live on until the
 decease of my dear wife Sarah Moore after her decease the whole
 of said Plantation to be equally divided between my ^{two} sons
 William Moore and Samuel Moore and to be for them
 and their heirs forever and if either of them shall decease

without leaving a child but live then the surviving brother

without leaving an lawful heir then the surviving brother
shall have the whole of said plantation to be for him and
his heirs forever I do also by this my last will and Tes-
tament authorize and direct my Executors hereafter named
after my decease to dispose by publick sale all my moveable
property and pay to my two illegitimate Grand Daugh-
ters Becky Moore and Kethen Crawford Moore the sum of
five pounds each after my decease the balance of the move-
able estate to be equally divided between my dear wife Sarah
Moore and my well beloved daughter Sally Moore and my
well beloved daughter Margret Moore I give and bequeath unto
every son John Moore ten shillings also I give and bequeath

shall have the whole of said plantation to be for ever and

his heirs forever I do also by this my last will and Tes-

tament authorize and direct my Executors hereafter named

after my decease to pay by publick sale all my movable

property and pay to my two illegitimate Grand Daugh-

ters Becky Moore and Ketron Crafford Moore the sum of

five pounds each after my decease the balance of the move-

able estate to be equally divided between my dear wife Sarah

Moore and my well beloved daughter Sally Moore and my

well beloved daughter Margret Moore I give and bequeath unto
