 that my Executors and Executors herein after mentioned shall
 sell my lands for the best prices they can get & they are in-
 jured to make a good & sufficient title for the same that
 shall be paid to my son John Wiley out of the amount of

of the land Two hundred and fifty dollars which shall be in full of his legacy & that my inargable Estate & the balance of the money arising from the sale of the land (after my just debts & funeral charges are paid) be laid out in land by my said Ex^r & Ex^{rs} as they shall think best & that the rest of my children (my son John excepted) shall be supported of said land together with my wife so long as they shall live single & it is my desire that when my youngest son arrives at the age of twenty one years that an equal divide be made of the land to three property then in the hands of my Ex^r & Ex^{rs} among my children, my son John excepted, or so soon thereafter as they can with convenience except one third ^{part} of Estate to be reserved for the use of my wife so long as she lives, & after her death to be divided in the like manner. Secondly I do hereby appoint my wife Eleanor Wiley & my son John Wiley my Executors & Executor to execute this my last Will & Testament Witness my hand & seal the above date.
