I give to my daughter Ann Bullen and her heirs full power full authority and sole privilege by her paying up to ^{the} other legacies the price

that said George will be appraised that Heaven to her during her natural life and at her decease to fall to the heirs of her own body

I allow my negro woman Jan and her children to ~~make choice~~ to live with any of my children they please by their paying up

to the other legacies in hundred and thirty pounds ~~but not more~~


