to the Heirs of Abner Prosser Deceased so soon as he arrives
at the age of twenty one Secondly I Bequeath to my gra
son John Prosser one hundred and three acres of Land

at the age of twenty one Secondly I Bequeath to my grand
son John Troxell one hundred and three acres of land
on the same conditions as stated in Abram Troxell

will. Thirdly I Bequeath two hundred acres of land
adjoining to the above tract of one hundred and three
acres to be equally divided between the three children

of Abram Troxell deceased. As also all ^{my} money and move-
able estate of less paying fifty pounds to Daniel Hoib
when he arrives at the age of twenty one & fifty dollars
to each of his Sisters Betsey & Sally Hoibman to be paid
to them as soon as they arrive at the age of twenty one

I bequeath to my Daughter Christiana two dollars
to be paid at my Decease. Finally I Bequeath
to Jacob Sutter all rents of the farm whereon I
now live I Wish to be buried in the same place

on the following conditions. To wit s^d Fuller shall
keep all buildings on s^d Farm in good repair and
return the Farm and Buildings in good repair to
the Heir Daniel Hoilman when he arrives at age 3^d
Fuller shall also pay over to the said Daniel Hoilman
two hundred dollars when he Delivers up said Farm
He shall also pay over to the Heirs of Abner Froxell
Deceased fifty dollars each as they arrive at age And
for the purpose of carrying into effect this my last
will and Testament I have named James McGaughey
& Jacob Fuller as my Executors and I do hereby Invest
them with full power for that purpose In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal
this twenty third Day of May one thousand eight
hundred and twelve

Jacob Fuller an Executor named in the last will & Testament
of Christopher Holman dec'd in open Court refused to take upon him-
self the Execution thereof and it appearing by the certificate of the
Judge another Executor named that he in like manner
refused on motion of Edward Graham & Robert White letters
of administration with the said will annexed are granted
therein in due form they having made oath according
to law and together with Jacob Fuller & Henry Holman

their securities entered into & acknowledged bond on the
penalty of \$5000 with legal condition
