In the name of God amen I David Rogers being but weak in body but
perfect mind and memory do make this my last will & Testament
knowing that it is appointed for all men once to dye I assigne and give
& give unto the hands of the all mighty god and my body to
that providence of care to be buried at the discretion of my friends
first I allow all my just debts to be paid out of my personall estate
I will that my wife Elizabeth Rogers shall have the one third of all
my personall estate after my just debts is paid I will that she shall
have one horse a white two heas and bedding two horse
two one saddle and bridle four head of sheep and a share
part of house hold furniture and one year provision
for the family the balance of my moveable estate to be sold
the money to be put to interest for the benefit of schooling
children and and what ever balance is left to be equally
between my four Daughters when they become of age I will
allow my Daughters to be to the education of my children and
my son Jeremiah Rogers to have good care at the Exp of his
father to and likewise I will that my wife Elizabeth Rogers

plantation for to raise the children until my own children be
are then her to have the part that falls to the fore part her lifetime and
her death to have the land that falls to the fore part to be and the money
to be equally divided between my four children - Since that my son
Jeremiah Rogers at the age of twenty and years shall have a part of
my plantation lying on the west side of the great Road and beginning at
follows to wit: Beginning at a white oak sapling on William Rowlsons line
marked knob on the west of the plantation along the top of the Bridge
before the door of the dwelling which I now live in on the aforesaid plantation
beginning at William Rowlsons line from three acres more to
Daniel Oakes beginning at the top of the Bridge and lastly falling my estate
to be that there is no number cut and destroyed on my plantation except for
years of the farm and lastly as I make this my last will and Testament
I do hereby constitute and appoint William Rowlson & Executors of this
David Dougherty my last will and Testament Done this 10th day of March
in the year of our lord 1878 and lived in the presence of and attested with me

At Rockbridge Court September 17th 1809

Writing purporting the last Will and Testament of David Rogers deceased was produced in Court by David Dougherty one of the Executors therein named & proved by the oath of Silvanus Rowleson & George Blinger two of the subscribing witnesses thereto & ordered to be accorded And on the motion of said Executor who made oath according to Law probate thereof granted him and secured from an giving bond & security & he together with Mary Bailey his security entered into & acknowledged bond in the sum of \$2000 conditioned according to Law.
