of Rockbridge county, do make this my last will and
testament in the following manner, that is to say in the
first place I allow all my last debts to be paid, and
after all my last debts and funeral expences is paid,
I leave and Bequeath to my uncle Joseph McClung a
bond of one hundred dollars that James McClung and
him executed to my Mother Rebecca Heale, dated the
seventh day of December 1795, also a Bed and furniture,
also a chest
2nd I leave and bequeath to my Aunt Peggy Tate my
best bed and furniture, also two Cambrick musland gowns,
one spriged musland gown, one Leckemate musland Gown,
three pair silk gloves, one white shawl, one striped mus-
land gown & Colpper two cotton gounds, one table cloth

-land gown & Collyer two cotton gowns, one table cloth,
one nodd spread one calico spread, two calico gowns, one
black silk gown and my best saddle

3^d I leave and bequeath to my Aunt Petsey McChing
one pair Black silk gloves, one white shawl, and
umbrella, one cotton gown, two calico spreads, one dark
calico gown, and one saddle

4th I leave and Bequeath to Ellen Tate one white
shawl, one Black shawl, one calico gown and one silk coat

5th I leave and bequeath Phoeby Tate one brown silk
gown, one pair silk stockings, one chest of drawers

6th I leave and bequeath to Rebecca Tate one saddle
one white cotton coat

7th I leave and bequeath to Elizabeth Tate, my friend

- cambric musland gown, one white shawl
- 8th I leave and bequeath to Aunt Betsey Stuart one
her Musland gown, one Table cloth, one calico quilt not quilted
- 9th I leave and Bequeath to Dolly Stuart, one Jinknet
musland gown, one musland coat,
- 10th I leave and bequeath to Nancy Caruthers one cambric
musland gown
- 11th I leave and Bequeath to Polly McClung one sprig-
ed musland gown
- 12th I leave and bequeath Katty Chambers one chint gown
- 13 I leave and Bequeath to my uncle David Steele the one
half of my lands in Rockbridge county to him and
his heirs and assigns forever
- 14th I leave and bequeath to my son John

I leave and bequeath To my uncles John Allen
Thomas Paxton, William McCornick, and my cousin
John Meele the other half of my lands in said county
to each an equal part to them and their heirs for ever
15th I leave and bequeath to Melly Paxton one silk coat
And lastly I do hereby appoint my friends Joseph McBluing
and James Tate sole executors of this my last will and
testament, hereby revoking all other or former will by me
heretofore made confirming this and this only to be my
last will and testament In testimony thereof I have
herewith set my hand and seal on this 28th day of January 1807

decd was produced in court proved by the oath of John
Humphreys Samuel Humphreys two of the subscribing wit-
-neses thereto and ordered to be Recorded; And on the motion
of Joseph McBlung James Tate the Executors therein named
who made oath according to law, certificate is granted them
for obtaining probate thereof in due form they having to-
gether with John Alexander their security entered into
and acknowledged bond in the penalty of five Thousand
dollars conditioned according to law
