and Testament ~~that is today~~ principally and first of all I give and recom-

I recommend to the earth to be buried in decent Christian burial at the
discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general Resur-
rection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God and ac-
tending such worldly property or estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless
me with in this life I give bequeath and dispose of the same in the fol-
lowing manner and form. I give and bequeath unto my daughter
Elizabeth Tooley all my wearing cloaths and my household
and I give and bequeath unto my son George Tooley my bed and bed

Goods — I do also give and bequeath unto John Owens my Horse
and all my Cupboard furniture and my spinning Wheel

I therefore bequeath and desire that the money which is left after
my Just debts and Funerall Expences is Defrayed to be Equally Divided
Amongst my three Sons John Tooty George Tooty and Charles Tooty
and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my friends Leonard
Shaw and John Owens executors of this my last Will and testament
hereby revoking all other or former wills or testaments heretofore made
