except my Bureau which I give to Gezey Spence and lastly I do ap-
point Robert McCalpin and John Atwater executors of this my last
Will and Testament hereby revoking all other Wills or Testaments by me
heretofore made in Witness hereof I have set my hand and seal this 25th
day of March 1808 signed sealed and delivered to be the last Will and
